

Cookies Policy

This Cookie Policy describes the use of cookies and similar technologies that are used by Allegion Plc., its subsidiaries, and affiliates (collectively “Allegion”, “we”, “us”, “our”) on our Services (as defined on our Privacy Statement) and which include websites, mobile apps, applications, platforms, ad services, and other Allegion products and services.

To the extent any personal information is collected through cookies, our Privacy Statement applies and complements this Cookie Policy. For further information about how we process your personal information other than through cookies and similar technologies, including your rights and choices, please refer to our Privacy Statement.

Generally, you can choose whether to accept the use of cookies and similar technologies by changing the settings on your browser or by changing specific settings for the Services. However, if you disable cookies and similar technologies, your experience on the Services may be diminished and some features may not work as intended. For more detailed information about the specific cookies and similar technologies we use and your choices, please see below.

Cookie Categorizations

Allegion categorizes its cookies by the feature and function each cookie provides. When using our Services, you may encounter strictly necessary cookies (e. g. which are required for technical reasons), as well as optional cookies, including performance cookies, functional cookies, and targeting cookies, each of which is described in further detail below.

Strictly Necessary Cookies - These cookies are necessary for the Services to function and for security purposes. As such, they cannot be switched off. They are often set in response to actions made by you, such as setting preferences, logging in, filling in forms, etc. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some Service functionality will likely not work. **These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.**

Performance Cookies - These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our Services. For example, they help us to know which pages and content are the most and least popular, see how visitors use the Services, etc. **All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous.** If you do not allow these cookies, we will not know when you have used the Services and will not be able to monitor its performance.

Functional Cookies - These cookies enable the Services to provide enhanced functionality and personalization, such as to find the location of a vendor, supplier, etc., near you. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies, some or all of the Service functionality may not work properly.

Targeting Cookies - These cookies may be set through our Services by our third-party advertising partners. They may be used by those third-party providers to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant advertisements on other websites and web-enabled applications. **They do not store directly personal information**, but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

Social Media Cookies - These cookies are set by a range of third-party social media services that we have added to the site to enable you to share our content with your friends and networks. They are capable of tracking your browser across other sites and building up a profile of your interests. This may impact the content and messages you see on other websites you visit. If you do not allow these cookies, you may not be able to use or see these sharing tools.

Cookies and Similar Technologies We Use

When you visit our Services, we place a number of cookies on the device that you use to access our Services. Most of the data pertaining to these cookies, their placement, and their use may allow us to identify you. We use this information to gain insight in how you and other visitors use our Services by gathering statistical usage data and enabling us to provide a better user experience on our Services. Third parties, such as our service providers, partners, or customers, may also use cookies in connection to our Services, to help us provide our Services, for our marketing purposes, or to analyze the use of our Services.

Google Analytics. We use Google Analytics services, as provided by Google, Inc. (“Google”), which uses cookies and similar technologies to collect and analyze information about use of the Services and report on activities and trends. This service may also collect information regarding the use of other websites, apps and online resources. Pixel tags. We use pixel tags (also known as web beacons and clear GIFs) to, among other things, track the actions of users of our Services, measure the success of our marketing campaigns, and compile statistics about usage of our Services and response rates.

Your Choices about Cookies and Similar Technologies

You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject certain cookies. You can use our [Cookie Preferences](#) link or set or amend your web browser controls to accept or refuse certain cookies.
